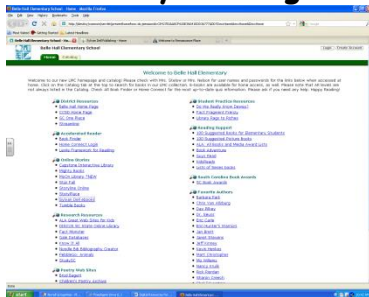


Home and School Digital Reading Resources for Belle Hall Elementary School

Welcome to the 2015-2016 school year! The Belle Hall library (LMC) is open from 7:15-3:10 daily. Students in Kindergarten - 1st grade check out 1 book each week. Grades 2-5 students may checkout 2 books at a time and may come any time during the week, not just on their assigned day! Parents may come in and checkout additional books for a week at a time. What is it? Everything you need for the LMC and reading! Home Page tab has many important links and the Library Catalog tab is there, as well.

What does it include? The homepage includes online resources for ebooks, research, poetry, author web sites and student sites of interest.

How do I access it? Go to the Belle Hall web page and click on the LMC Quick Link button. You do not need to log into Destiny itself. (<http://bellehall.ccsdschools.com/home>) Click on the **Catalog** tab to search the library books available in the Belle Hall LMC! Includes some online books and a universal search with citations. Ebooks are also available.

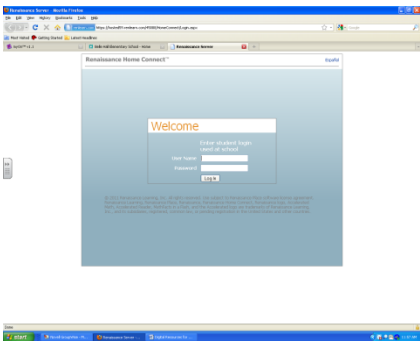

What is it? Animated and classic ebooks

How do I access it? go to <http://www.ccpl.org/> -click on **Downloadable Media** - you will need to put in your CCPL number.

AR Home Connect



What is it? This allows you to log into your child's AR test results. Children cannot take a test, but you can see the scores for each test and an average percent correct. The View My Bookshelf link lets you see all the quizzes your child has taken in the past. There is a link in the top right corner where you can go to set up an email notification each time your child takes a quiz. The Book Finder link lets you find the AR level for books your child is interested in.

How do I access it? Go to the Destiny home page and click on the link provided. Use your child's username and password (same as MackinVia)

Mackin backpack ids and passwords are the same as the MyOn user names and passwords on the front of this form.

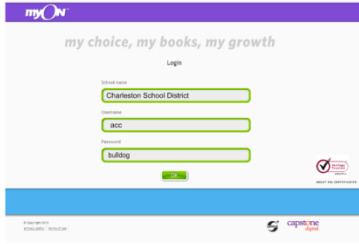
By logging in with your own user name you can check out ebooks and save books and favorites in your bookbag.

1st - 5th grade science

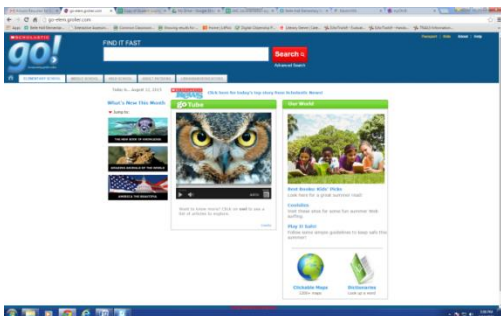
What is it? A database of animal facts, video clips, pictures, and research forms. There are also **Social studies**, **Biography**, and **Science** sections, as well.

How do I access it? linked on MackinVia - (you should not need the username and password through MackinVia, but just in case it asks:
